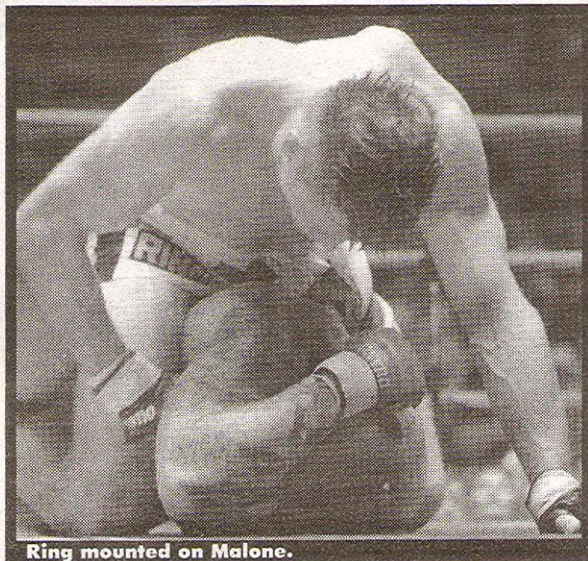


**MMA 185 lbs (Three 5-Minute Rounds):
NICK RING (AMC PANKRATION) VS. MIKE
MALONE (EASTSIDAZ)**

Both fighters picked their punches until Ring closed the distance when Malone followed through with a kick. Ring took Malone down, but Malone did a good job of scrambling back up to his feet. Ring pressed the clinch and kned Malone in the corner. Malone attacked with a guillotine, but Ring picked the Eastsidaz fighter up and took him down. Ring worked his way to the mount and then took Malone's back when he rolled face

control of the fight and rocked Miller with some hard punches and a strong sprawl. Vitale got Miller's back and sunk in a deep rear-naked choke. Somehow Miller got out of it and that seemed to mark Vitale's downslide. Miller took Vitale down and capitalized by getting Vitale's back off a scramble. Vitale posted up with his legs and tried to shake Miller off, but Miller secured the back position and slipped in a choke of his own. Vitale appeared to think for a second, apparently trying to decide if he could escape, but the choke was sunk in too deep and he was forced to tap out. The crowd ignited into a frenzy. Mayhem has clearly earned Hawaii fight fans' respect and admiration, judging by the uproar when Miller won the fight.
